BAKERY

Messers Findlay, Lawrence and Fairlie have been bakers in Tokomaru Bay. Mr. E. Lawrence was the Baker before Mr. Pat Fairlie. Mr. Pat Fairlie Mr. Bob Ingoe, Mr McDermott and Mr. Davis worked and trained with Mr. Lawrence. Then Mr. Pat Fairlie brought the bakery Mr. B. Ingoe continued working for him. As time went by others worked for Mr. Fairlie and Mr. T. Collins.

The bakery was made up of the cooking area the living quarters and a shop. The part used as the shop and later the flour store still stands today as the Haven. The only other remains is part of the oven.

Bread, cakes, scones etc. were supplied to shops in Te Puia, Uaipiro Bay, and Ruatoria. The Bakery closed between 1964 and 1966.

The part of the Bakery now known as the Haven was once a store owned by a Mr. McCulloch. He was a taylor by trade and sold mens chothes. Later the premises became part of the bakery.
